

PhD Student positions in Mathematical Analysis

The Department of Mathematical Sciences at the University of Oulu is seeking Phd Students (1-2) to work on geometric measure theory, fractal geometry or dynamical systems as a member of a research group which is a part of The Finnish Centre of Excellence in Analysis and Dynamics Research. The research of the group is concentrated on geometric properties of sets and measures using techniques from modern analysis, probability theory and dynamics. The research environment is highly international.

The salary is based on the teaching and research personnel pay scale levels 1-3, depending on the competence of the candidate. The personal work performance level is valuated separately. At the beginning, the salary will be approximately 2100 euros per month.
